Armenia	305-073	Young Women's Leadership Camp	Five local women invited 31 high school girls to attend a 3-day camp to learn about self esteem, gender roles, domestic violence, human trafficking, cooking, group sport exercises, team building and networking.
Benin	680-206	La Coquille: Education Program	This project will assist a local NGO called La Coquille to create three revenue generating activities to increase its capacity to give scholarships to students and cover its functioning costs. The facilities are an 8 acre Manioc Farm, two rabbit husbandry site and two boutiques of diverse school supplies situated at two other nearby schools.
Bulgaria	313-126	A Stage for Everyone	Renovated a school auditorium and provided multimedia/sound equipment to transform the space into a functioning theater/meeting/presentation room. Provided training for teachers to encourage student choir, dance, and theater performances.
Bulgaria	313-131	Classroom Resources	Purchased modern equipment and learning materials to assist 35 special needs and cognitively disabled students, and renovated a classroom to serve students with hyperactive disorder and aggressive behavior.
Bulgaria	313-132	Youth Integration	Built the capacity of the local Municipal Youth Center to allow students to learn about victims of violence, trafficking of persons, drug abuse and prejudice against minority communities, worked to broaden community awareness and increase cooperation between local and national organizations to address problems facing youth.
Bulgaria	313-141	Youth Basketball Team	Brought together Bulgarian and Roma youth to participate in a year-long, six tournament basketball challenge to learn about teamwork, sportsmanship, and shared cultural understanding.
Bulgaria	313-154	Children's Recreation Area	Remodeled a minority community's recreation space to allow children a safe place to play away from the busy street.
Burkina Faso	686-149	Girls and Women's Education Conference	Worked with a national women's association to conduct lessons on the practical importance of girls' education, transmitted radio interviews, discussed the impact of women's education on the household in a public forum for parents, held public conferences in two District capitals, and delivered a petition to engage local officials regarding women's rights and education.
Burkina Faso	686-150	Girls and Women's Education Conference	Worked with a national women's association to conduct lessons on the practical importance of girls' education, transmitted radio interviews, discussed the impact of women's education on the household in a public forum for parents, held public conferences in two District capitals, and delivered a petition to engage local officials regarding women's rights and education.

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Cameroon	694-143	Community Granary	Built a community granary for local farmers to store up to 5200 sacks of corn, beans, cassava, and millet—allowing farmers to safely save their crop and sell it at a more profitable time.
Cameroon	694-146	School Construction	Built a local school for over 80 students, allowing them to attend school in their own village instead of walking long distances each day, and provided a series of workshops on the importance of girls' education.
Cameroon	694-164	Elementary School Classroom Construction	Built a permanent elementary school building for the Mbororo population, a traditionally marginalized group of nomadic pastoralists in northern Cameroon.
Cameroon	694-166	Raising Pigs	Worked with a local research institute to generate income by raising pigs, a method chosen to create new jobs, teach essential business skills to community members, and allow village women to have time to attend adult learning and health workshops.
Cameroon	694-167	Improving Health and Nutrition with Soybeans	Implemented a soybean cultivation project to improve access to health foods for children. Trained community farmers on how to cultivate, manage, and maintain soybeans production.
Cameroon	694-169	Seminar on Soy Cultivation	Worked with a local NGO to provide a three-day seminar on soy cultivation and cooking to provide essential nutrients missing from the local diet and to improve soil fertility.
Cameroon	694-176	Peer Educators HIV/AIDS Prevention Training	Trained 12 village members over 5 weeks to become peer educators of HIV/AIDS transmission and prevention, and implemented a six-month action plan to provide community health seminars.
Dominican Republic	517-382	Community Water and Sanitation	Provided a rural community with the funds to continue the construction of a water distribution system powered by a centrifugal pump. This pump provides sufficient and clean water to meet the residents' demands as well as those of the community centers.
Dominican Republic	517-384	Library Resources	Built a library by adding a second story to an already existing community center, and stocked it with children's books and art supplies to promote literacy and education at a young age.
Ecuador	518-334	Build a Library, Build a Future	Constructed and filled a library for an elementary school in the Northern Sierras. Additionally, the project expanded the numbers of computers in the library.
Ecuador	518-342	Sustainable Agriculture & Income Generation	Educated community members in sustainable agriculture and livestock production practices. Specialists trained community members on how to increase and diversify crop yields organically, as well as how to manage and increase livestock production sustainability.
Ecuador	518-348	Health Team Training	Integrated traditional medical practices into the westernized hospital to ensure culturally adequate treatment of all patients. This was achieved through training sessions for hospital staff that increased their knowledge and awareness of the need for traditional practices for the indigenous patients.

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Ecuador	518-351	Workshop for People with Special Needs	The workshops for 25 handicapped people included candle making, can wood carving, sewing, and farming. The sale of the products produced in the workshops provided the salaries for assistants working in a home for up to 6 homeless and multi-handicapped people.
Ethiopia	663-010	Youth Center	Established a youth center providing the youth population with a communal location to socialize and receive health information. This youth center will provide a number of services with the intention of educating the youth about the outbreak of HIV/ AIDS.
Ethiopia	663-012	Rural Water Station	Built a concrete water "borno" which will keep the water source from contamination from local live-stock and increase the flow of the congested spring.
Fiji	411-142	Beekeeping Training	This project provided equipment to train small scale beekeepers and create new beekeeping-related businesses. Additionally, beekeepers were provided with necessary skills and equipment to create business in honey production, bee breeding, and equipment manufacturing.
Fiji	411-144	Community Footpath	Footpaths and a driveway were constructed in a small village of 384, which was frequently left with deep mud and water following heavy rain fall. The construction of these paths helped to address transportation issues as well as the health risks associated with travelling through flooded areas.
Gambia	635-062	Community Garden	Created a community garden to provide income (particularly for women), give a variety of healthy diet options, address malnutrition, and help eradicate poverty in this village.
Gambia	635-064	Resources for a Community Nursing School	Created a resource center with up-to-date books and resources on research on nursing, community health and related sciences and provided teaching aids to strengthen practical nursing skills.
Ghana	641-269	Kindergarten/Nursery School	Improved the Kindergarten facility and keep more of their children in school, and also attract many children from surrounding communities who do not have access to such infrastructure.
Ghana	641-296	High School Computer Lab	Rebuilt the computer lab of this community senior high school and to provide the community with local, reasonably priced internet access.
Ghana	641-297	Computer Lab	Provided a junior high school in central Ghana with a computer lab equipped with 20 computers and a printer. The lab will provide them with the opportunity to use computers and better prepare for their exams in ICT and other subjects. The staff will also be able to use the resources to be more productive educators and administrators.
Ghana	641-300	Rabbit Rearing	This project aims at helping to introduce the relatively new alternative livelihood project of rabbit rearing to 3 communities, and train 21 individuals in rabbit rearing.
Ghana	641-301	Youth and Recreation Center	Constructed a youth center to further pursue educational endeavors and grant them access to services that would otherwise not be provided, such as art education, peer tutoring, career counseling, language development and organized athletics.

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Ghana	641-303	Community Library and Computer Lab	Built the local community a computer lab to help with the education of the local Junior Secondary School and prepare them for the ICT exams.
Guatemala	520-237	Eco- Classrooms: Friends of the Environment!	This project built two eco-classrooms for a small town middle school. The classrooms allowed 80 students to learn comfortably. Additionally, walls of the classrooms were built with eco-bottles instead of cement blocks, contributing to a healthy and clean environment.
Guatemala	520-240	Community Pila Project	Installed pilas, cement utility sinks, for each of the women in the community's women's group. The pilas provided the women with a more sanitary way to store water and do washing, and minimized the physically demanding aspect of daily chores.
Guatemala	520-245	Improved Cook Stoves Project	Provided more efficient stoves for families to cook on, reducing the amount of heat loss and smoke in the home, keeping children safe from open flames, and reducing the number of trees cut down for firewood. Trained the community on the construction, use, and maintenance of the stoves.
Kenya	615-175	Educational Activity Center	Worked with a local NGO to furnish a children's educational activity center with three sets of playground equipment, educational materials, and a forest of indigenous trees.
Kenya	615-176	Youth Group Beekeeping Business	Provided funds to purchase improved beehives for a community local development organization, allowing the hives to be harvested many more times a year and generate more profit to be put toward feeding orphans and vulnerable children.
Kenya	615-190	Promoting Women's Hygiene	Trained local girls to make their own reusable sanitary pads, provided classes on women's issues such as proper personal hygiene, menstruation, HIV/AIDS awareness, sexual violence, and goal setting.
Kyrgyz Republic	307-155	Village Greenhouse Project	Worked with local health NGO to build a freestanding greenhouse to create 5 local jobs, to provide locally grown produce, to increase sales for bazaar vendors, and to improve the local diet by providing fresh, healthy food options.
Kyrgyz Republic	307-159	English Classroom Refurbishment	Provided a computer, printer, scanner, and copier for a network of 32 secondary school English teachers to build a database, back up documents, exchange teaching ideas, and use computer-based English language lessons.
Kyrgyz Republic	307-168	Hygienic School Latrines	Provided funding to remodel student dormitory washroom facilities and host training classes on the importance of maintain clean facilities, proper hand washing, and good hygiene.
Mali	688-332	Solar Power for a Health Center	Installed solar electricity in the community health center to allow for better emergency nighttime care, improved birth care, and to power a new refrigerator for essential vaccinations and injectable medications.
Mali	688-336	Women's Clothing Making Co-Op	Provided startup funds for a women's clothing co-op, designed to create jobs and generate sustainable income for local women, as well provide funds for the education and nutrition of local orphans.

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Mali	688-338	Maternity Clinic	Provided funds for the construction of a new maternity clinic to alleviate overcrowding, provide a private space for consultations and births, and create a new space to educate the community about women's health issues.
Mali	688-351	Community Library	Constructed a Library, Media, and Meeting House building to increase education and literacy and to act as a meeting space for local Associations, Cooperatives, and Committees.
Mexico	510-010	Solar Cook Stoves	110 participants from four communities were provided solar HotPots, as well as environmental education and training on living sustainably. The program improved the health of families and reduced the impact to forests, soil, and biodiversity in the surrounding watersheds, which were adversely affected due to local reliance on wood from surrounding forests to cook and heat water. Finally, the program lessened the economic burdens of its participants.
Mexico	510-013	Bridging the Digital Divide	This project was part of a larger effort to collect funds to provide new computers, printers, software, and related equipment to a local non-profit called El Puente de Esperanza (The Bridge of Hope). El Puente offers a residence and educational opportunities for poverty-stricken young people between the ages of 14-21 who were identified by teachers in their home towns as showing exceptional educational promise.
Mexico	510-014	College Science Lab	Purchased the laboratory Programmable Mechanical Convection Oven to study polymer compositions over time in a school science lab.
Moldova	261-206	Playground for Street Children	Installed a playground at Evrica, a public institution focused on bettering the lives of street children ages 5-18. Partnered with a local youth organization designed to help children develop their psychosocial/motor skills through organized games and activities.
Moldova	261-213	School Reading Program	Purchased 885 copies of 437 book titles to add to regional school library and implemented a new reading program to give students more interesting class assignments and to encourage students to read on their own.
Morocco	378-126	Community Trash Management	Worked with the local environmental group to purchase and distribute trash bins, to hire a trash service, and to implement environmental and health education campaigns.
Mozambique	640-015	Let a Child Learn	Renovated a community preschool, built new classrooms, and painted the area to provide a more stimulating environment for its 33 students. Purchased teaching supplies, educational materials, and sports equipment.
Mozambique	640-020	Cultural Center	Created a center for children to development in the areas of theater, music, visual arts, dance, sports and culinary arts. This will reduce their chances of engaging in risky or unhealthy behavior.
Niger	683-170	Grain Bank	Built a grain bank to create a source of fixed-price grains that are sold below hunger season market prices. This would be able to improve the health of the community members by increasing the availability of affordable grains.
Niger	683-174	Grinding Machine	Provided the people of Tsanwa with a grinding machine. With the grinder it will be easier to pound beans and peanuts thus adding more protein into everyone's diets.

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Niger	683-179	School Desks for 3 Classrooms	Built three concrete classrooms to replace those usually rebuilt with millet stalks each year and furnished them with bookcases and desks for 60 junior high students.
Panama	525-136	Composting Latrines	Constructed 26 composting latrines to address the lack of adequate sanitation systems in a small subsistence agriculture community.
Peru	527-020	Healthy Homes and Dry Bathrooms	Constructed dry bathrooms for over 60 families to help address water and agriculture contamination problems, as well as parasitic intestinal infections. Provided training for families on nutrition, solid waste management, and environmental protection.
Peru	527-022	Community Latrines	Provided 2 pour-flush latrines and 9 bathrooms to rebuild this community's sewage and water systems which were destroyed by a 2007 earthquake.
Peru	527-033	Healthy Homes and Families	Implemented a year-long health campaign focused on mothers with children under 3 years of age, to teach hygiene, child-care, nutrition in infants and mothers, sexual and reproductive health, trash management, and dental care.
Philippines	492-365	Community Library and Learning Center	Constructed a Municipal Library/Community Learning Center (ML/CLC) that supports the educational needs of the community. Additionally, the project incorporated new environmentally-friendly and sustainable methods in the construction of the building and allowed for active community involvement.
Rwanda	696-001	Books for Peace	Worked with Books for Africa and 14 Volunteers to bring over 10,000 books and 42 computers and to build libraries in communities across Rwanda, allowing students to learn English and improve their IT fluency.
Senegal	685-140	Healthy Babies	Funded a five-month contest to encourage mothers in three villages to learn about simple changes to improve their own health, as well as their children's. Provided for lessons in hygiene, vaccines, better nutrient-enriched foods, family planning, and malaria prevention.
Senegal	685-143	Community Resource Room	Worked with a local NGO to provide a community resource center with over 200 language education books, tables, chairs, computers, and internet. Provided free computer classes for any interested community member.
South Africa	674-061	Playground Construction for Informal Settlement	Built a safe playground for young children including a play structure and sand box as well as building swings, a slide, and a netball court for the older youth with a place to store sports equipment.
South Africa	674-065	Kalahari Strong Girls Group	Developed an after school program for the female students attending the local primary school. Mentors from the village will run the weekly sessions and employed females from various professions will act as guest speakers, sharing how they achieved success. Additional meetings will cover topics such as: healthy living, female empowerment, risk management, self esteem, goal setting, and teen pregnancy/STDs.

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Swaziland	645-079	HIV Support Group Community Garden	Funded the construction of a suitable fence, a borehole and water tank, and a small storage shed over a period of eight weeks so that the HIV-positive support group can begin to cultivate nutritious vegetables, which are essential to the diet of those living with HIV.
Swaziland	645-083	Neighborhood Care Point Kitchen Project	To construct a kitchen so a group of motivated community women that volunteer their time as neighborhood caregivers can help support and feed the many orphaned and malnourished youth of the area.
Swaziland	645-084	Sanitation and Supply Improvements for a Preschool	With this community contribution, the preschool will be provided with a sanitary pit latrine, proper water collection and containment, and classroom supplies for the education of preschool children.
Tanzania	621-218	Secondary School Resource Room	Provided a local secondary school with three computers and an internet modem, allowing students to improve their English, to learn how to use a library and the computer, and to foster self-learning and the discovery of new ideas.
Thailand	493-160	Preschool Cafeteria Project	Addressed a sanitation issue at a local preschool where children ages 3-5 were eating on the classroom floor in crowded conditions. This project allowed for the construction of a cafeteria that included tables, chairs, and a food preparation and serving area.
Togo	693-343	Latrine Development	Built community latrines to protect the environment and the health of local farmers and their produce.
Tonga	421-124	Camp GLOW	Camp GLOW, Girls Leading Our World, was a week long sleep-away camp designed to empower its participants, 50 girls and 15 young women. The camp emphasized the importance of being informed, active, independent, and responsible citizens through games, sports, arts, technical training, and educational sessions.
Uganda	617-055	Life skills Vocational Training	Trained deaf Ugandan youth in areas of tailoring, hairdressing/barbering, craft making/handiwork, and computer training, providing skills to generate income and inspire confidence in a professional career.
Ukraine	343-155	A CURE: A Community United to React to an Epidemic	Worked with the A-CURE program to educate the community about HIV/AIDS and the environment, built an AIDS memorial and children's playground, and implemented a summer camp program to clean up the local environment.
Ukraine	343-157	First Rate Textbooks	Provided funding for better English textbooks in the community school.
Ukraine	343-158	Media Education Initiative	Purchased a laptop and projector, trained teachers on new ways to incorporate multi-media technology in the classroom, and hosted a community film to celebrate the opening of the improved computer room.
Ukraine	343-194	English Textbooks	Provided funding for better English textbooks in the community school.
Ukraine	343-230	English Textbooks	Provided funding for better English textbooks in the community school for students grade 2-9.

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Vanuatu	461-036	Community Center	This project provided cement, timber, and steel rods for the construction of a community dining and events hall. The center serves as a gathering place for custom ceremonies, family celebrations, and other community events.
Zambia	611-054	Teacher Housing	Provided materials for a teachers housing unit to encourage more qualified teachers to move to this village, as well as two new classroom blocks for classes and extracurricular activities at the school.
Zambia	611-057	Rural Health Clinic	Completed the construction of a rural health clinic to give this community more ready access to emergency health care, to HIV/AIDS testing and treatment, and to standard medical care for treatable ailments.
Zambia	611-066	Resource and Counseling Center	Constructed and furnished a community center with books, computers, and furniture, providing a safe place for students to learn about HIV/AIDS and teen pregnancy and for community members to learn computer skills and improve their literacy.
